

# InfoPrint Manager for Windows (5648-F36) V2.3 and InfoPrint Manager for AIX (5648-F35) V4.3 Enhancements

#### **Overview**

Effective Enterprise Output Management (EOM) is vital to driving reductions in the Total Cost of Operations (TCO) of output and related print processes. Ricoh's premier EOM solution, InfoPrint Manager, is a robust enterprise application print management tool designed to fully support output processes, including distributed, production, and enterprise application printing.

With a wide array of submission methods and data stream capabilities, InfoPrint Manager for AIX and InfoPrint Manager for Windows provide powerful capabilities designed to reduce output environment TCO in the following ways:

- Simplifying enterprise print environments through print server consolidation and reductions in the need for print server administrators. Tight management of output from enterprise applications, such as SAP, to provide better tracking and control offloads workload from expensive enterprise application administrators who often spend their valuable time dealing with print related issues.
- Improving operator / end user efficiency through centralized user, administrator, and management
  interfaces for system wide output management control. Configurable notifications keep users,
  administrators, and operators informed when critical events happen or action is needed. Access to a
  centralized point of control of the output system allows the help desk to provide a simple and efficient
  error recovery.
- Increasing asset utilization through vendor-agnostic manual job and queue management for complete
  control over when and how jobs are processed and printed. Combining device load balancing, process
  automation, and job scheduling with robust and automated transform capabilities enable flexible job
  flows.
- Decreasing the cost of print through audit-ready accounting and end user LDAP authentication for cost
  analysis and bill-back. Reprint capability and legacy job manipulation nearly eliminates the need to go
  back to the job's source application. Authenticated pull-printing can eliminate unneeded distributed
  print output and increases print room security. High availability configurations are designed to
  eliminate business process interruptions that depend on output to be successful.

Optional related software is easily integrated to facilitate seamless migration of legacy Xerox LPS/Metacode applications to open formats, as well as conversions of print applications into PDF to send as mail attachments, archive, or present on the web.

## **Overview and Description**

#### **New Java GUI Enhancements**

The InfoPrint Manager Administration and Operations graphical user interfaces (GUIs) have been improved to further enhance usability and productivity. The InfoPrint Manager Java GUIs now include new drag-and-drop and paging functionality. The new drag-and-drop capabilities allow users to quickly and easily drag one, or multiple, objects from one view to another. The new paging capabilities allow users to more easily navigate within various views on a page-by-page basis.

## **Hyper-V Environment Support**

InfoPrint Manager for Windows is now supported on the Microsoft Hyper-V Environment, further enabling the cost savings and increased availability associated with virtualized environments.

## **Capability to Dynamically Support AIX Printers**

InfoPrint Manager for AIX has added DSS functionality to better support non-predefined printers. A new server attribute has been added to support querying for any dynamically supported AIX printers. Using this functionality, the InfoPrint Manager GUIs display the descriptive names of the printer models in the drop-down list after creating an actual destination. The InfoPrint Manager AIX DSS was also updated to dynamically support trays and media.

## Server attributes default for "count pages" set to "all"

The InfoPrint Manager Server attribute count-job-pages now sets the default value to "all" to better align with customer's actual use.

#### **Linux LDAP command line client**

The Linux Command Line Client has been enhanced with LDAP (Lightweight Directory Access Protocol) authentication capabilities for job submission. When using LDAP authentication, each submitted job can be recorded in InfoPrint Manager's accounting log with the users' unique identifying information, so that chargeback for print can be done with great accuracy at the user level.

### **Automated Backup Destination**

InfoPrint Manager has added a new Automated Backup Destination capability. With the Automated Backup Destination functionality, if a target printer device is not functional, there is an easy way to automatically reroute subsequent jobs pending to print at that destination to an identified backup device. To enable



Automated Backup Destinations, new actual destination attributes have been included to enable/disable this new function, control the number of seconds between each attempt to move the pending jobs, and identify the backup destinations to be used.

## Support Unicode in PCL Secondary

InfoPrint Manager's PSF-Other destination type has been enhanced to now support TrueType/OpenType fonts. As a result, the existing limitation of Unicode AFP data on the PCL Secondary has been removed.

## PostScript/PDF2AFP Single Cell Halftone Support

InfoPrint Manager has added Single Cell Halftone support. Using single cell halftone technology can improve the print quality on the InfoPrint 4100 printer family for certain jobs that are transformed using the PS2APF and PDF2AFP transforms. New server attributes have been included to indicate the single cell type to be used and to separately set the thresholds for line art, text, and images where the transforms should use the single cell halftones.
