What's new in Release 1.4?

These new functions and updates are included in Line2PDF Plus, Version 1.4:

Installer is now available for Line2PDF Plus.

A dedicated installer simplifies the deployment and setup of the Line2PDF Plus transform.

Thales Sentinel licensing support added.

Line2PDF Plus now includes integration with Thales Sentinel for secure and flexible software licensing.

Updated the Bouncy Castle open source package.

The Bouncy Castle OSS library was upgraded to version 1.74 to improve security and maintain compliance.

Line2PDF Plus - Limitations from a Previous Release

This document contains a short description regarding the limitations for Line2PDF Plus, version 1.4.

The current limitations with the Line2PDF Plus Transform include:

- Input text data stream must be mappable to code page 1252. Double Byte Character Set (DBCS) is not supported.
- TRC characters are not supported.
